To obtain a Library card you need to show:

- Photo ID and proof of residency,
- A parent or guardian must be present to sign for anyone under 18.

Library cards are free. Your HPL card can be used at any other library in the Mid-Hudson Library System.

Lost Library Cards:

First replacement is \$2.00; \$5.00 thereafter Library cards must be updated in person every three years.

Borrowing materials from the library

Patron Accounts are private.

Library cards are not transferrable.

Music CDs, DVDs and magazines circulate for 7 days. Books & Books on CD circulate for 3 weeks. DVD sets with more than 2 DVDs circulate for 14 days.

Items may be renewed **twice**, in person, or at www.beaconlibrary.org, or by phone (845) 831-1134, ext. 104.

Materials with holds may not be renewed.

Items on hold must be checked out by the person who requested the hold – relatives or friends must present the card of the person requesting the hold in order to pick up items on the requester's behalf.

Borrowers are responsible for the cost of lost and damaged materials. The cost is not refundable.

Late Fees: 10 cents per day for all items except DVDs, (.25 per day). No charge for days the library is closed.

Outdoor book return, near the entrance, is always open for your convenience.

Howland Public Library serves the 26,000 people who live within the Beacon City School District, and all who work, attend school, or visit here. The Library is supported by the taxpayers in the Beacon City School District, plus other public and private sources.
