### **Submission Guidelines: HPL's Small Works Benefit Exhibit**

- Each artist may submit one (1) work to the exhibit.
- All artwork submitted to the Small Works Benefit Exhibit must be for sale.
- Work should be priced under \$100.
- All work must be no greater than 20 inches in the largest dimension.
- Work must ready to hang. (No sawtooth hangers.)
- By submitting your work to HPL's Small Works Benefit Exhibit, you agree to donate 50% of proceeds from each sold piece to HPL. HPL will return all unsold artwork.
- HPL reserves the right use images of work submitted on our website and in any advertising associated with this exhibition.
